Fire Glory

Introduction

Ex 24:17 *The sight of the glory of the Lord was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel.*

- God will reveal Himself to you as a Consuming Fire! Once you walk into **His Revelation Glory**, you will be confronted by **His Fire Glory** that purifies you!

Three Types of Fire

- A. Destroying/Judgment Fire
- B. Approving Fire
- C. Refining Fire

A. Destroying/Judgment Fire

Rev 20:9 *They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them. 10 The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.*

- The final destiny of Satan, the beast and the false prophet is the destroying fire in the lake... God is a God of Justice!

Acts 19:18 *And many who had believed came confessing and telling their deeds. 19 Also, many of those who had practiced magic brought their books together and burned them in the sight of all. And they counted up the value of them, and it totaled fifty thousand pieces of silver. 20 So the word of the Lord grew mightily and prevailed.*

- When you are on fire with God, that fire will judge the ungodly and the occultic.

Num 11:1 *Now when the people complained, it displeased the Lord; for the Lord heard it, and His anger was aroused. So the fire of the Lord burned among them, and consumed some in the outskirts of the camp. 2 Then the people cried out to Moses, and when Moses prayed to the Lord, the fire was quenched.*

- God is a righteous judge who is all-knowing. No hidden motives can remain hidden but all will be exposed by the righteous judge.

Ps 89: 46 *How long, Lord? Will You hide Yourself forever? Will Your wrath burn like fire?*

- The Judgement fire of God is critical to prevent total destruction. If God did not intervene in the wilderness to judge sin, the entire community would have perished! In God's mercy and grace, the young generation were able to enter the promised land.
- This is happening now! An entire old generation – old not in age but as old wineskins, will miss out on their destiny. Remember how short our time is: **Ps 89: 47** *Remember how short my time is;*

For what futility have You created all the children of men? 48 What man can live and not see death? Can he deliver his life from the power of the grave? Selah

Ex 9: 23 *And Moses stretched out his rod toward heaven; and the Lord sent thunder and hail, and fire darted to the ground. And the Lord rained hail on the land of Egypt. ... 26 Only in the land of Goshen, where the children of Israel were, there was no hail.*

- Judgement must first begin in the house of the Lord. Can you expect God to grant us such authority in the end times? We need such authority to survive and thrive in the end times.

B. Approving Fire

Lev 9:23 *And Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of meeting, and came out and blessed the people. Then the glory of the Lord appeared to all the people, 24 and fire came out from before the Lord and consumed the burnt offering and the fat on the altar. When all the people saw it, they shouted and fell on their faces.*

- Consuming fire results in worship! God's glory is seen and it releases His fire of **APPROVAL**.

1 Kgs 18:38 *Then the fire of the Lord fell and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood and the stones and the dust, and it licked up the water that was in the trench. 39 Now when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces; and they said, "The Lord, He is God! The Lord, He is God!"*

- The fire of God both **approved and endorsed** Elijah as God's prophet.
- In the End Times, churches and ministries which are of God will have His fire. Those not of God will be left in the cold. The **FIRE** keeps you from the deception of the enemy.
- What can we sacrifice to God today that can invoke His **APPROVAL, FAVOR and GREAT GRACE?**

Acts 4:33 *And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.*

- When the glory of God keeps on increasing in the church and the conviction of the people grew, they did the extraordinary. What a powerful testimony!

Acts 4:34 *Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, 35 and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.*

- Every need in the church was met.

Acts 5:1 *But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession. 2 And he kept back part of the proceeds, his wife also being aware of it, and brought a certain part and laid it at the apostles' feet. 3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? 4 While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? You have not lied to men but to God." 5 Then Ananias, hearing these words, fell down and breathed his last. So great fear came upon all those who heard these things. 6 And the young men arose and wrapped him up, carried him out, and buried him.*

- Ananias and Sapphira were believers but there was deception in their hearts. Things done in the flesh will stop God's move. When the glory of God comes, His fire comes and destroys what is in its way. God removed them to continue the move of God.

1 Chron 21: 26 *And David built there an altar to the Lord, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called on the Lord; and He answered him from heaven by fire on the altar of burnt offering.*

- David had sinned and God had sent a plague upon Israel (**1 Chron 21:16** *Then David lifted his eyes and saw the angel of the Lord standing between earth and heaven, having in his hand a drawn sword stretched out over Jerusalem. So David and the elders, clothed in sackcloth, fell on their faces. 17 And David said to God, "Was it not I who commanded the people to be numbered? I am the one who has sinned and done evil indeed; but these sheep, what have they done? Let Your hand, I pray, O Lord my God, be against me and my father's house, but not against Your people that they should be plagued."*)
- God sent His fire of APPROVAL to stop the destruction.

Ex 19:18 *Now Mount Sinai was completely in smoke, because the Lord descended upon it in fire. Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly. 19 And when the blast of the trumpet sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice. 20 Then the Lord came down upon Mount Sinai, on the top of the mountain. And the Lord called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.*

- The whole mountain shook when the Lord descended on it.
- In the same way, God will shake the heavens and the earth **Hag 2: 6** *"For thus says the Lord of hosts: 'Once more (it is a little while) I will shake heaven and earth, the sea and dry land; 7 and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of All Nations, and I will fill this temple with glory,' says the Lord of hosts.*
- It means He wants to descend on earth and the knowledge of His glory shall fill the earth.

Ex 24:17 *The sight of the glory of the Lord was like a consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the eyes of the children of Israel. 18 So Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.*

- God wants to invite us to ascend into the mountain of His glory. Mountains are symbolic of the Kingdom of God.
- Are you ready to enter fully into the Kingdom of God to experience the fullness of His glory?

Ex 3:2 *And the Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire from the midst of a bush. So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. 3 Then Moses said, "I will now turn aside and see this great sight, why the bush does not burn." 4 So when the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am."*

- In the **GLORY OF THE FIRE** that burns there will be a voice! There will be clarity in **the voice of the fire of God**. We are stepping into this...
- There must be a **turning aside to see the fire of God** as John did in Revelation to see Jesus.

C. Refining Fire

Mal 3:2 *“But who can endure the day of His coming? And who can stand when He appears? For He is like a refiner’s fire And like launderers’ soap. 3 He will sit as a refiner and a purifier of silver; He will purify the sons of Levi, And purge them as gold and silver, That they may offer to the Lord An offering in righteousness.*

- It is a time of cleansing (more external) and purifying. Purifying like silver or gold goes deep into the person. ‘Purge’ means to totally eradicate. God will purify us.

Lk 3: 16 *John answered, saying to all, “I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.*

- Jesus wants to come directly to us and release His holy fire on us.
- God is calling us to prepare the way for the Lord Jesus to come to the church. Why? If the church is not prepared, the fire could come as a destroying fire and NOT as a refining fire.

Rev 1:14 *His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; 15 His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters; 16 He had in His right hand seven stars, out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength.*

- Isaiah encountered the Lord in all His splendor and said, “Here am I! Send me.” The reason for Him coming to us is so that He can send us.

Deut 5:24 *And you said: ‘Surely the Lord our God has shown us His glory and His greatness, and we have heard His voice from the midst of the fire. We have seen this day that God speaks with man; yet he still lives.*

- God’s voice is in the midst of the fire. The fire will burn up everything in its way. The rubbish of our lives, the idols in our lives – burn them.

Ex 29:9 *And you shall gird them with sashes, Aaron and his sons, and put the hats on them. The priesthood shall be theirs for a perpetual statute. So you shall consecrate Aaron and his sons. ...33 They shall eat those things with which the atonement was made, to consecrate and to sanctify them; but an outsider shall not eat them, because they are holy.*

- This a new season of the Lord – enter with consecration. Be set apart for the Lord.

1 Pet 2:4 *Coming to Him as to a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God and precious, 5 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.*

- We are holy Kingdom priests.

Mal 3:4 *“Then the offering of Judah and Jerusalem Will be pleasant to the Lord, As in the days of old, As in former years.*

- Once again that our offerings would be accepted that we might be blessed.

Ex 25:1 *Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying: 2 “Speak to the children of Israel, that they bring Me an offering. From everyone who gives it willingly with his heart you shall take My offering.*

- What will you bring to the Lord today as your fire glory offering?

Ex 29:35 *“Thus you shall do to Aaron and his sons, according to all that I have commanded you. Seven days you shall consecrate them.*

- Our sanctification must be complete according to the prophetic word.

Ex 29:43 *And there I will meet with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by My glory. 44 So I will consecrate the tabernacle of meeting and the altar. I will also consecrate both Aaron and his sons to minister to Me as priests. 45 I will dwell among the children of Israel and will be their God.*

- The church is sanctified by the glory of God.
- Let there be a new generation of Kingdom priests.
- God Himself will dwell among us – His abiding presence.
